

Boarders' Possessions

It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that all possessions of their son/daughter are clearly labelled with their name on the inside of clothing, bags, books etc. Individual, lockable safes are provided for each boarder in their bedrooms to keep their valuables secure.

Each boarder is advised to open their own bank account in one of the many local banks in Ashford town, within a short walk of the school, for quick and easy access to their money. We do not advise boarders to arrive at school carrying large sums of money in cash.

Passports must be handed in to Mrs Vicary, (the Estates Manager) for safekeeping during the term.

Uniform

During the school day pupils in Years 7 – 11 are expected to wear the full school uniform. In the Sixth Form (years 12 & 13) they must be smartly dressed in business attire (suit, formal shirt and tie for boys; skirt or trouser suit, formal top, shirt or blouse, for girls, polished shoes of a conventional style). Once the formal day is over (after afternoon activities), boarders are allowed to wear their own clothes for the rest of the day, as well as at weekends.

寄宿生个人物品

家长应确保子女的所有个人物品，如衣物，袋子和书本等等标明了该子女的姓名。每位寄宿生的宿舍都提供个人保险柜，用于存放贵重物品。

学校强烈建议每位寄宿生到附近的任何一间银行开一个个人户口，以方便管理个人金钱。我们不建议新抵达的寄宿生随身携带大量现金。

所有护照必须递交给 Mrs Vicary (学生物品管理人)，以确保在学期中可被安全保管。

校服

在上课期间，七年级至十一年级的学生应穿着全套指定校服。预科生需穿着整齐的商务套装（男生：西装，正式衬衣与领带；女生：西装半截裙或西裤，正式上衣或衬衣；一双干净的普通皮鞋）。放学后和周末的时候，寄宿生可穿着自己的衣服。
